Primary Responsibilities:

Disinfect common areas, including bathrooms, every hour.

Part-time Hours: We are looking for several Part-time Screeners who can work flexible shifts at our Winnetka and/or Lake Forest campuses. A typical shift is at least 10 hours per week. Examples of available shifts include:

1-3 years' experience in general office administration or customer service

Basic knowledge of personal computers

Demonstrated experience using computers to accomplish typical office tasks, such as creating and sending business emails and keeping track of activities or tasks.
