Music Moves Me®: Dalcroze Eurhythmics (age 6-9) • 45 minutes • 15 weeks • \$135.75 – MIC private instruction student; \$297.00 – non-MIC private instruction student

Music Moves Me® is designed to explore musical concepts such as rhythm, pitch and improvisation through movement and play. By applying the concepts of Dalcroze Eurhythmics, a unique approach to music education, kids explore and discover how music feels in their bodies. Please note: This is a drop-off class; however, parents and caregivers are required to be in proximity of the classroom and are invited in weekly at the end of class for a show-and-share.

Practical Musicianship for Parents • 45 minutes • 15 weeks • \$135.75 – MIC private instruction student's parent; \$297.00 – non-MIC private instruction student's parent

The goal of this class will be to help parents provide a supportive environment for their children during the week and to give them a greater understanding of how to help their child develop as musicians. People enrolled in this class will develop rudimentary note reading, ear training, and rhythmic skills that will be applied to practicing lessons. This class will help our students develop more quickly as musicians, help parents and students regularly create a meaningful musical experience, and may even encourage parents to begin studying musical instruments as well.

The Fall semester of the course will be divided into three parts. The first five weeks will be devoted to discussing practicing strategies for students and ways of encouraging practice as part of an everyday routine. The second five weeks will be centered around refining the ear and developing note reading and basic musical literacy in the parents, and finally, the end of the semester will be about how we use harmony and melody to make musical choices.
